POLICY FOR ADMISSION OF STUDENTS UNDER SPORTS QUOTA

In terms of Section-34(2) of the Adamas University Act 2014, a weightage of 10% in the eligibility criteria (marks or grade in the qualifying examinations) across all courses in the University may be given to those sports men/women who desire admission subject to the following conditions:

- The students have participated in the National Level Championship/School Level Championship in the State/in the Country.
- They have to appear and qualify in the fitness test organized by the University.

Concession and Guidelines

- The students admitted under the sports quota shall be entitled for full fee waiver (Academic Fee) for the entire course period including examination fee.
- The students shall have to maintain at least 25% attendance in a semester. The participating students will be provided exemptions for classes and assessments as per the UGC sports norms. Such students shall be treated as 'On duty' and their attendance shall be marked 'Present" on the specified number of days, certified by the concerned Dean. Remedial classes shall be arranged to make the system more supportive.
- The students have to appear for all semester examinations and fulfil all requirements for award of degree.
- The students pursuing other than Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics program, shall be permitted to write examinations in their mother tongue/regional language.
- The policy is applicable to all the students admitted in the Sports Quota.
- Should there be any difficulty faced in the implementation of the above, the matter shall be referred to the Vice-Chancellor whose decision in this regard shall be final.
